Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read and explore a range of story books - Identify and discuss story features including characters and settings - Develop enjoyment and motivation in Reading - Individual reading
Speaking and Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Role play area – Materials Workshop - Discussing Building structures and the use of a range of materials - Sorting materials - Using puppets to put on a show for others and retell stories
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sorting materials for puppets - Sorting materials (floating & sinking) - Mixing and changing materials - Making shadows - Seasonal changes
Computing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sharing audio books - Plan and rehearse story for own audio book - Use digital images and maps to explore the UK, countries and oceans. - Film a puppet show
Humanities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Route to the 4th little pig's house & devise a simple map - Locate own home - Locate 4 countries of UK, capitals and seas - Locate 7 continents and 5 oceans - Locate countries of stories/tales – Australia, Jamaica, India and China - Use digital images, world maps, atlases and globes - Use simple compass directions and locational and directional language.
