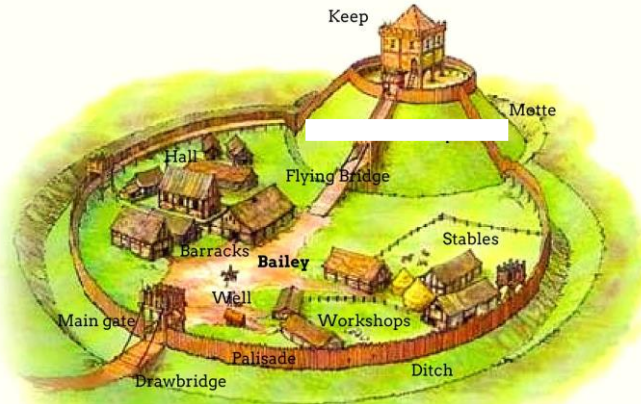

Vocabulary

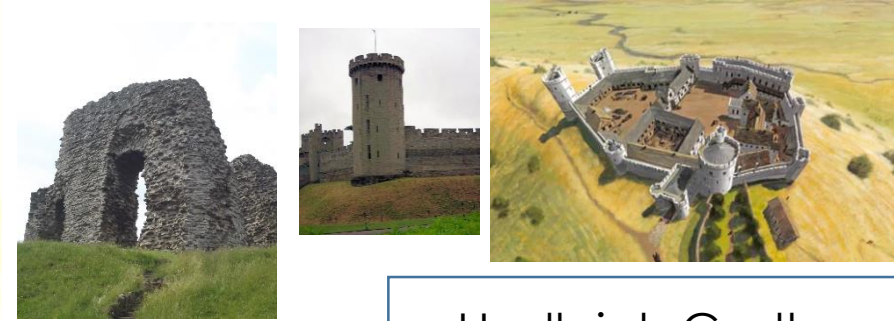
allies	A group of countries that are on the same side.
castle	a large building, fortified against attack with thick walls, battlements, towers, and in many cases a moat.
colonialism	Colonialism occurs when a country or a nation takes control of other lands.
feudalism	the dominant social system in medieval Europe.
fortification	a defensive wall or other reinforcement built to strengthen a place against attack.
medieval	relating to the Middle Ages.
nobles	a person of high rank or birth.
Normans	a member of a people of who settled in Normandy from about AD 912 and became a dominant military power in western Europe and the Mediterranean in the 11th century.
peasants	a poor smallholder or agricultural labourer of low social status.
siege	a military operation in which enemy forces surround a town or building, cutting off essential supplies, with the aim of compelling those inside to surrender.



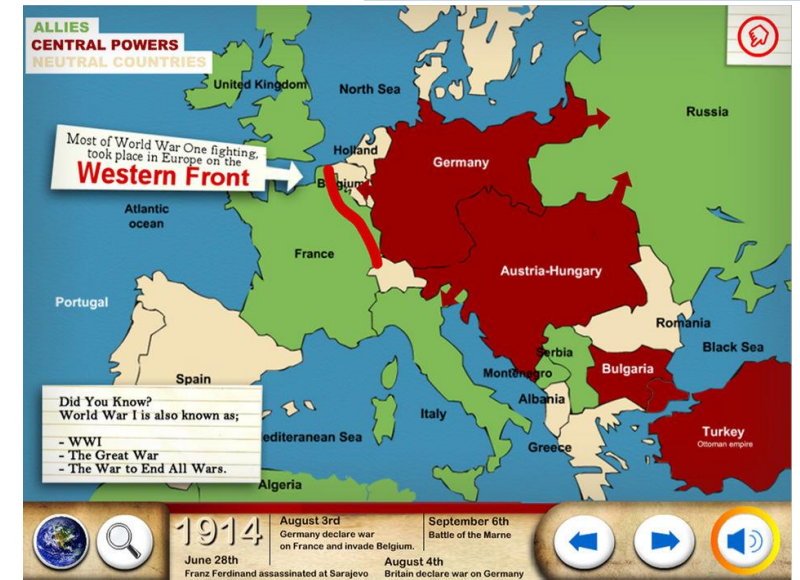
Motte and Bailey Castle
