



Uniform

At Darlinghurst Academy our children wear their uniform with pride. Uniform information has been shared with parents outlining branded items and those that are optional. You can purchase items from our current supplier www.schooluniformdirect.org.uk and non-branded items from other retailers. In addition, our uniform will be available from www.PaulsDiscount.co.uk from December. Black school shoes are to be worn. All personal items are to be labelled, including drink bottles, lunchboxes, coats and hats to ensure their return, should they be misplaced. School bags should be a small rucksack as they are stored in lockers. This also supports a hands free, walk to school. *Book bags are still available. Finally, please note that all hair accessories/head coverings are to be blue, black or white.

Aspens Catering: Meal prices: £2.30 per day.

Aspen's provides the meal service for our children following a three weekly cycle, including special themed days. These will be shared via school ping. Payments for school meals are to be made in advance via ParentPay for children in Nursery and KS2. Please ensure your child's account does not go into arrears. Weekly or monthly payments can be made.

Children in Reception, Year one and Year two are entitled to universal infant free school meals irrespective of family income (there is no need to apply for these). Free school meals are also available for those who are eligible due to family circumstances. If you are applying for free school meals for the first time, please use the online application: www.southend.gov.uk/fsm. Any free school meal renewals should use the 'Registration for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium' form (available on the Darlinghurst Academy website or from the school office).

Packed Lunches: As a healthy school, we promote healthy packed lunches. Foods containing nuts are prohibited for the health and safety of children with serious nut allergies. Lunches should not contain glass bottles, cans of fizzy drinks or sweets. Packed lunches should be brought in a suitable, labelled container.

Little Mariners:

Extended care arrangements will be in place from 1st September for those children who have pre booked and paid for sessions. Our breakfast club opens at 7:30am each day and costs £3.50 per session. Our after school provision runs until 6:00pm every day and costs £8 per session, reduced to £4 if pupils are collected by 4:15pm.
