As part of their geography learning this half term, the children in Year 2 will be spending a day in Old Leigh and Leigh Beach on **Wednesday 22nd March (Lobster) and Thursday 23rd March (Shrimp)**.

The children will leave school at 9:15 and walk to Old Leigh. They will survey the environment checking for human and physical features and research how the local area is used. They will identify key features of a coastal area and compare Leigh to a seaside resort in the past.
