



Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of their science learning this half term, the children in Year 2 will be going to Call of the Wild Zoo on Thursday 25th May 2023.

The children will leave school at 9:15 and travel by coach to Call of the Wild arriving at approximately 10:00. They will return to the academy before the end of the school day. During their visit, they will explore the animals and use their learning from the half-term to identify their habitats, diet and classification.

The children will also have a talk by zookeepers on the different ways that animals can be classified as well as the opportunity to take a closer look at some of the animals.

Children are expected to wear full school uniform but should wear comfortable shoes or trainers as the day involves plenty of walking. Please provide your child with a morning snack, packed lunch, water bottle (there is tap water available to refill water bottles) and a waterproof coat or hat and sunscreen depending on the weather. Please be aware that the children will be carrying this throughout the day so a suitable backpack is preferable (otherwise a named carrier bag will suffice). If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for your child, please indicate on the slip below.
