Vocabulary	
civilization	the society, culture, and way of life of a particular area
continent	the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica).
earthquake	a sudden violent shaking of the ground, typically causing great destruction, as a result of movements within the earth's crust or volcanic action.
indigenous	originating or occurring naturally in a particular place; native
Maya	a member of an indigenous people of Yucatán and elsewhere in Central America.
rainforest	dense forest rich in biodiversity, found typically in tropical areas with consistently heavy rainfall.
rural	relating to, or characteristic of the countryside rather than the town
settlement	a place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.
urban	relating to, or characteristic of a town or city
volcano	a mountain or hill, having a crater or vent through which lava, rock fragments, hot vapour, and gas are or have been erupted from the earth's crust.
